I hereby confirm and undertake that:

- 1) I am over 18 years of age and can afford the services of a private veterinary practitioner, and will ensure that **vaccinations are kept up to date** and in the case of illness or injury will take the dog to the vet for treatment without delay.
- 2) That "he/she" will have a sleeping area raised off the ground with protection from the wind

- & rain and that there is adequate shade during the hot summer months.
- 3) That I will allow "him/her" to sleep indoors at night especially in winter.
- 4) That I will not willingly allow "him/her" to roam the streets or run free at night and that I will fit a leather or strong webbing collar with a suitable identification tag.
- 5) I am prepared to pay the non refundable adoption fee (see website for details).
- 6) When I have found a dog or am no longer interested in adopting one, to please contact us so we can remove your listing.
- 7) That the completion of this form and/or the checking of my property does not guarantee me a dog from Border Collie Rescue.
- 8) That I have taken note of the following special request from Karen:
 - a. Collies need a huge amount of attention and exercise.
 - b. Border Collies are extremely afraid of fireworks.
